N-Act Theatre performance Friday 18th November

On Friday 18th November, C9 will be attending a performance in our main hall at 10:30am. The performance has been arranged and funded through Essex Youth Service.

This performance explores gangs and knife crime in our society today. Research by the Youth Service and N-Act has shown that there have been an increasing concern of knife crime and county lines across the country, including in Essex. The research N-Act has done has been translated into this performance which offers interactions with learners where learners will witness a court scene, ask questions, and will decide whether one of the characters is guilty or not – helping them understand the impact of knife crime and involvement with gangs has on the individual and those around them.

The whole cohort will attend this performance which lasts approximately an hour and will therefore not attend their LS2 learning session.
