Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Cohort 10 Spring Enrichment Week

We are delighted to once again bring our Spring Enrichment week to learners and families. During the week, each cohort will be taking part in activities either on site or off. Our focus for Cohort 10 for this week is preparing them for the challenges they will face over the next 18 months; a week of experiences for your child to develop their skills for the world of work and for post-16 education.

We have designed the following programme for your child with Mr Ramsay, Careers Advisor to support your child's development of skills they will use for work experience later this year:

Monday 20 th March	Learners will attend normal learning sessions, but will have a time slot for a mock interview.
Tuesday 21 st March	Optional talks/presentations from local and national employers such as Eastlight community homes and the DWP.
Wednesday 22 nd March	We will be visited by MADE training, a specialist company that runs workshops to teach revision techniques to learners. In addition, learners will spend time in work experience preparation workshop with their learning group leaders. This ran last year and ensured that the learners were well prepared for the world of work they will enter in June.
Thursday 23 rd March	Learners will attend normal learning sessions, but will have a time slot for a mock interview.
Friday 24 th March	We will be visited by a representative from the Army for an Army Elite Skills day. All of the learners will attend an interactive assembly in the morning, followed by a 40 minute workshop in groups. The workshop and assembly are to develop cognitive thinking, problem solving and team work. (When not in the workshop they will attend normal sessions)

There is no charge for any of the activities this week, and we hope that your child enjoys the week and finds it useful in preparing for the world of work later this year and their mock exams after Easter.
