Dear Parent/Carer,

**Re: Cohort 11 Spring Enrichment Week; 20<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

We are delighted to once again bring our Spring Enrichment week to learners and families. During the week, each cohort will be taking part in activities either on site or off. Our focus for C11 for this week is preparing them for the challenges they will face over the next few months with their GCSE exams, and a day to out to celebrate their time as learning groups and a cohort, whilst developing life skills and confidence.

We have designed the following programme for your child designed to support their forthcoming exams, and to build confidence:

Monday 20 <sup>th</sup> March	<b>Science exam prep day.</b> The learners will work with their Science teacher to look at revision material and exam technique and sit a mock paper.
Tuesday 21 <sup>st</sup> March	<b>Maths exam prep day.</b> The learners will work with their Maths teachers to look at revision materials and exam technique and will sit a mock paper on the day.
Wednesday 22 <sup>nd</sup> March	<b>English exam prep day.</b> The learners will work with their English teachers to look at revision materials and exam technique and will sit a mock paper on the day.
Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> March	<b>London Bingo Run</b> The whole cohort will visit London for the day. Their task will be to visit as many sites on the predefined Bingo Board using the London Underground and by walking. They will take a coach to Stratford, please arrange for your child to be at school by 7:30am so we may leave promptly at 7:45am and will be given a Travel Card to use for the day. The learners will work in their Learning Groups and will be accompanied by their Learning Group leader and additional staff. Planning will take place in LS5 time with their Learning Group Leader and we hope that this will give them some "downtime" as a cohort from exams and develop skills and independence. They will collaborate to work out their route and whilst staff are with them, the learners will make decisions about the route they will take. They will all meet up for lunch at Soho Square to check in, and then be back at Stratford for the coach home by 4pm.
Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> March	Learners will attend normal learning sessions.

The cost of this Enrichment Experience is **£34.00** which covers the coach and the Travelcard. Payments can be made on ParentPay (preferred method and includes a 1.275% charge).
