C9 Business Studies, Media Studies and Technology visit to Disneyland Paris 2025

We are very excited to launch a new Enrichment experience specifically for learners in C9 (current C8) who will be taking Media Studies, Business Studies or Technology next year at GCSE. The trip to Disneyland Paris has been specifically designed to create an opportunity for real life application and understanding of the subjects. The 3-day, 2 night visit will take place from the **10th - 12th February 2025**.

The framework of the trip is a mixture of a day in the park, with seminars and workshops. Whilst in the park, the learners will have subject specific workbooks to support their learning. The provisional itinerary is as follows:

Further details of the final itinerary will be shared with families next year at a pre-trip meeting, date to be confirmed.

The learners will be staying in a Bed and Breakfast Disney affiliate hotel located 7 minutes by coach from the Park. The total cost of the trip, which includes all transport costs (coach for the duration and Channel crossing), a one-day Hopper pass to Disneyland Paris theme parks, accommodation (bed and breakfast), meal vouchers for two evening meals and subject specific seminars/workshops is **£475**.

We are initially asking for an expression of interest and are keen to be able secure the booking as soon as possible as the availability does go quickly. **Please indicate on ParentPay if you are interested in your child attending this trip by Friday 5th July.** Should we have sufficient interest in the trip from families, the first deposit of £50 to secure the booking for each child will be due on the 8th July (this is non-refundable). We will then arrange an instalment plan for the remainder of the cost, payable through ParentPay.

Should your child withdraw from the visit, a refund will be issued following the guidance by the tour operator, excluding the non-refundable deposits (We are bound by the travel companies' terms and conditions, these can be found at: <https://www.ngttravel.com/media/u2gfhf3k/next-generation-travel-booking-terms-and-conditions-23-june-2023.pdf> section 12.3.
