Re: C11 Dance Show 2025 with participation from C9 - 10th February 2025

Cohort 11 dancers have been working hard on developing Dance material for their BTEC Component 3 practical exam. They have also worked alongside other cohorts to put together 'Honywood's 2025 Dance Show'.

As a group, they have worked so hard to develop their confidence in choreographing as well as performing. I am delighted that they have this opportunity to perform to a live audience before their actual practical assessment at the beginning of March. This experience will help them to develop the necessary skills needed to be successful in this externally assessed component. The dancers had to stick to a Brief from the exam board. This year's brief is based on the stimulus of 'Joint Effort.'

The show is classed as their MOCK assessment; however, evidence from this will be used for the actual practical assessment if needed.

There will also be some material performed by the Dance club, these learners have been choreographing material themselves in preparation for the event, as well as Cohort 9 dancers who are using this opportunity to prepare for when they are in Cohort 11.

We will have rehearsals during the school day on Monday 10th February. Please support your child in organising their costume for this date, so they can rehearse wearing it.

The show is on Monday 10th February from 6pm and until approximately 7pm. Tickets will be available from Learner Reception soon at a cost of £6 for adults and £4.50 for children.

Your child will need to be in school from 5.15pm on the 10th February with all costumes and equipment required to perform.

During the performance we will be taking some photos and filming. Some performances may also be shared on the school website and on our social media so that we can celebrate the learner's achievements with the rest of the community.

We will require your consent for your child to be included in the concert and additionally for any recordings and for photographs to be used. The learners' names will not appear on any media and we will only use the material on our school's subject directory, main website and social media adhering to our normal guidelines. **Please indicate your permission via ParentPay by 4th February.**
