**Re: C11 Spring Enrichment 2025**

As part of the C11 leavers' offer this year, we have arranged for them to have a day in London taking part in a 'Scavenger Hunt'. Last year, the C11's had a fantastic day, following clues to London landmarks that spelt out their destination, spending time with their Learning Group and Learning Group Leader enjoying the sights of our capital city. By using public transport to navigate the city and walking between landmarks, learners will develop life skills and confidence.

In addition, during this week C11 will sit further mock exams in core subjects: English, Maths and Science.

We have designed the following programme for your child, designed to support their forthcoming exams and build confidence:

Monday 24 <sup>th</sup> March to Wednesday 26 <sup>th</sup> March	<b>Mock Exams - programme to follow</b>
Thursday 27 <sup>th</sup> March	<b>London Scavenger Hunt</b> The whole cohort will visit London for the day. Their task will be to work out the clues as a group and visit as many sights as possible using the London Underground and by walking. The clues and sights will lead to the final destination and meet point before returning home.  They will take a coach to Stratford, <b><u>so please arrange for your child to be at school by 7:30am so we may leave promptly at 7:45am.</u></b> Learners will be given a Travel Card to use for the day and will work in their Learning Groups, accompanied by their Learning Group Leader and additional staff.  Planning will take place in advance during LS5 time with their Learning Group Leader and we hope that this will give them some 'downtime' as a cohort from exams, whilst helping develop life skills and independence. During the day, they will collaborate to determine their route and work out the clues; whilst staff will accompany them, the learners will be making decisions about the route they will take. They will meet their coach at the final destination, ready to leave by 4:00pm. We anticipate our arrival back at school between 5:30pm and 6:00pm ( <i>Please check Facebook for updates on the day</i> ).
